

Tuition and Fees

The Pacific Graduate School of Psychology is a private, not-for-profit institution of higher education. Tuition and fees are established each year to cover operating expenses and salaries of professors and staff.

PGSP is committed to providing quality education in small class settings. The student/faculty ratio is very low, allowing for extensive contact between professors and students. All professors have obtained the highest degrees in their profession. Students receive excellent academic advising and career counseling. Students in the undergraduate program have access to all student services at both the Foothill College and PGSP campuses. These include library and IT services, food services, career and psychological counseling services, health services, tutoring and writing assistance, access to handicap services, student activities, athletic facilities, etc. All students are assigned to a graduate student mentor, who is available to assist them with coursework and personal advice.
