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Topics:

This group focuses on the research areas of aging, neuropsychology and depression. In particular, the research will involve integrating different areas of research to provide a more “holistic” study of cognitive and affective disorders. In addition, I am open to talking with students with other research topics in these general areas. The research projects will allow the students to gain research skills from designing a study, literature reviews, recruiting subjects, administering tests and interviews, data entry and data analyses, presenting at professional conferences, and possibly writing manuscripts. Students will also be encouraged to conduct their own research projects and compete for student awards, fellowships, and grants. This training is aimed to help the student become a more independent researcher by the time he/she advances for dissertation.

3. A writing sample - usually a paper submitted for a psychology class while a student at PGSP.
