

Mental Health Interviewer Position

OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT

The purpose of this study is to evaluate the natural course of opioid use in patients who were prescribed extended-release/long-acting opioids to manage chronic pain as part of their routine clinical management. This is an observational, epidemiological study that was mandated by the FDA as a post-marketing requirement. The VA Palo Alto HCS system is one of nine sites contributing to the data collection.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct semi-structured in-person and telephone interview assessments with Veterans.
- Assist Project Manager and Research team with Administrative tasks.

REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS

- Master's degree in Clinical/Counseling Psychology or Social Work or related field
- Ability to start as soon as possible and to commit to 16-20 hours per week for a minimum of 1 year.
- Experience working with patients with complex mental health disorders
- Effective interpersonal skills, excellent verbal communication and written skills.
- Organized, detail-oriented, self-directed, and dependable.
- Ability to independently work in different locations to conduct onsite, in-person interviews.
- Ability to travel for onsite training.
- Existing VA Without Compensation Appointment (WOC) is preferred.
