



Palo Alto University Directory Information

The Family Educational Rights and privacy Act (FERPA) declares that an institution may release certain information from a student's educational record without the written consent and defines Directory Information as the following: "Information contained in an education record of a student which would not generally be considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if disclosed." (1988 Final Regulations)

At Palo Alto University the following is considered Directory Information and **may** be released to a third party without the student's written consent:

Directory Information at PAU:

- Name
- PAU Email Address
- Phone number(s)
- Classification (i.e., sophomore, senior)
- Major field of study
- Periods of enrollment
- Degrees pursued
- Credit hour load (full-time, part-time, etc.)
- Degree(s) awarded
- Date(s) of conferral
- Honors
