Instruction

As a reminder, All classes scheduled at the **Mountain View** campus will be held **online for the first two weeks** of fall quarter. Classes at the Mountain View campus will resume in person on **October 3, 2022**.

If your classes are scheduled at the **Calvin Campus**, your classes will continue in person as scheduled starting **September 15, 2022**.

Health & Safety

To ensure the health and safety of everyone at PAU, we expect that face masks are to be worn in classrooms except when speaking.
