# Research Program and Digital Consultation Center

- Oversee i4Health projects, and ensure implementation of decisions related to projects and research studies
- Lead the development of digital projects of the i4health and Digital Consultation Center, and provide relevant training, support, and guidance to PAU faculty and students
- · Monitor progress of i4Health research studies, and organize and maintain study databases
- Assist with research activities (grant preparation and reporting, IRB, statistical analysis, data summaries)

### Strategy and Development

- Serve as the point person for i4Health
- Establish and develop relationships with internal and external faculty, consultants, and project officers from granting agencies
- Evaluate strategic impact of long-range plans, opportunities being considered, and new projects.
